Involving students in scientific-research work was the tradition of Iakob Gogebashvili Telavi State University department of Georgian Language and Literature for years.

Temporarily stopped scientific circle of Georgian literature is reopened on the faculty of Humanities.

The circle represents students' group, members of which are students with high academic progress, those interested in scientific-research work.

Number of scientific circle members is not defined. It is an open organization, any person can attend it and take part in scientific discussions together with the circle members. Being a member of students' scientific circle is optional. It combines students from all three levels (BA, MA, PhD).

Tinatin Tushabramishvili, assistant professor at the department of Georgian Philology is the leader of literary-scientific circle.

Schedule for meetings and agenda is defined according to the preliminary worked-out plan.

Students' scientific circle goals are:

1. Making conditions proper for students scientific-research work;
2. Student's scientific work should be in compliance with the sphere of his/her interests;
3. Supporting and developing students' scientific-research work;
4. Promoting formation and improvement of students' scientific-research skills;
5. Promoting students' involvement in organizing scientific conferences;
6. Making relations with students' scientific organizations of different universities;
7. Spreading information among students regarding scientific conferences;
8. Promoting publication of students' scientific works;
9. The members of the circle will plan meetings with famous writers.

Scientific Supervision

1. The supervisor of students' scientific circle should be academic personnel from the university;

2. The supervisor of students' scientific circle is obliged to help students in selecting interesting research subject; in connecting to the scientific supervisor; the circle supervisor's duty is to carry out students' scientific conferences and work out their schedule, open and close the sections, summarize the section reports, award the winners, organize publication of students' works and other issues.
3. All specialists of the department of Georgian Philology are obliged to be actively involved in the working process of literary-scientific circle.

Scientific circle of literature is accredited to:

1. Listen to the scientific reports of the circle members;
2. Select reports for students' scientific conference;
3. Organize students' discussions regarding different scientific matters.

Students' scientific circle supervisor is also obliged to present the report about the fulfilled work to the department of Georgian Philology at the end of each academic year.
