

Prospective Students

Target Group 1:

Applicants who have completed the first two years, preferably in Economics-related specialties at the Armenian National Agrarian University (ANAU). Students will pursue a Diploma from ANAU and a Certificate from Texas A&M University.

The application package includes:

- ▲ Completed application form (download at atc.icare.am or pick up at the Admission Office);
- ▲ Copy of passport or National ID Card;
- ▲ A photo (3x4 size);
- ▲ Copy of the student record book;
- ▲ Support documents, if any (certificates, support letters).

Target Group 2:

Applicants who have graduated from ANAU or other higher institutions and wish to pursue only a Certificate from Texas A&M University.

The application package includes:

- ▲ Completed application form (download at atc.icare.am or pick up at the Admission Office);
- ▲ Copy of passport or national ID card;
- ▲ A photo (3x4 size);
- ▲ Copy of the undergraduate diploma;
- ▲ Copy of undergraduate transcripts;
- ▲ Support documents, if any (certificates, support letters).

All applicants must have English proficiency sufficient to continue their studies in ATC (knowledge of English is tested during the admission test and the interview).
