Former capital of East Georgia (Iberia) from the 3rd century BC to the 5th century AD, Mtskheta is indeed a social and cultural phenomena. Mtskheta sites show the high artistic and cultural level attained by the ancient kingdom of Iberia (East Georgia) - one of the first states in the world to adopt Christianity as its state religion in AD 337. Mtskheta is a city in Mtskheta-Mtianeti province of Georgia. Currently a small provincial capital, for nearly a millennium until the 5th century AD, Mtskheta was a large fortified city, a significant economic and political center of the Kingdom

of Iberia. Due to the historical significance of the town and its several outstanding cultural monuments, Mtskheta's contribution to the world's civilization is invaluable. Mtskheta municipality's administrative districts are loaded with unique historical, cultural and religious monuments. Each of them is unique in its antiquity and importance.
