Requirements for the conference articles

Paper volume 5-9 pages

Please ensure that the article segments follow the proper sequence:

1. Scientific field/discipline of the article
2. Title on the next line with one line space (bold), font size 14
3. Author(s)' last name and first name (bold), font size 14
4. Name of the institution, font size 12
5. Abstract – An abstract is mandatory at the beginning of the article in the language in which the paper is written, font size 11;

At the end of the article, an abstract in English is mandatory for papers written in Georgian and Russian, while an abstract in Georgian is required for papers written in English and Russian.

- **In the abstract, it is mandatory to translate the title of the paper, the author's last name, first name, and the organization/institution.**
 - The abstract must be:
 - Informative (should not contain general phrases); compact, conveying the essence of the work, research results, and be understandable to the reader even without reading the publication; should not contain material that is not included in the main text of the publication.
 - The abstract's length: between **200 and 250 words**.
 - Written in proper Georgian/English/Russian literary language.
6. After the abstract, **5-7 keywords** in the language of the article and in English.
7. Discussion. Length: **5-9 pages**, including formulas, tables, and figures.
- The article must be printed on **A4** paper using a text editor (**Word**).
 - Line spacing: **1 (Single)**.
 - Paragraph indentation: **1 cm**.
 - Page margins: 20 mm (File, Page Setup, Margins).
 - Top and bottom margins: **20-20 mm**.
 - Font: Georgian text: **Sylfaen, size 12**
Russian text: **Times New Roman, size 12**
English/Latin text: **Times New Roman, size 12**
 - Use quotation marks in Georgian and English/Latin text as shown („“), and in Russian text use («»).
 - Use an em dash (–) in the text, and a hyphen (-) within words.
 - Author names in the article should follow this format: **Shanidze, 1953; Пушкин, 1821; Chomsky, 1998**.
8. References: Font size 10. Entries should be listed in alphabetical order at the end of the article according to the sample:
- **During the book citation:** Last name, first name of the author. (year of publication), publisher, place of publication. E.g.: Widdowson H.G. (2003) Linguistics. Oxford University Press. Oxford. New York
 - **During the article citation:** Last name, first name of the author (year of publication), Title of the article.// Title of the Journal or book, volume, number, pages. E.g. Capizzi, M.T. and Ferguson, R. (2005), "Loyalty Trends for the Twenty-first Century", Journal of Consumer Marketing, Vol. 22 No. 2, pp. 72-80.
